The Treasured Tamariki Foundation Limited, operating as Treasured Tamariki Early Childhood Education and Childcare Centre, is a social enterprise of Mums4Mums Charitable Trust, which provides free in-home support for new mums and babies—an important maternal mental health initiative. Our early childhood centre is dedicated to giving every child the best start in life through a safe, nurturing, and culturally grounded environment.

Guided by care, connection, and community, we partner with whānau to foster each child's potential. With donor and community support, we build stronger families, resilient communities, and brighter futures.



Mums4Mums Charitable Trust understands that parenting can be overwhelming, and when families experience emotional or social challenges, the burden can feel even heavier. Our mission is to ensure that no mother feels alone and that every child has access to the essentials they need to thrive. We believe small acts of kindness create lasting change, which is why we provide not just material aid but also emotional, social, and practical support to struggling mums.

Many mothers in our communities face unexpected hardships, including maternal mental health challenges and social isolation. Disturbingly, New Zealand has the worst maternal outcomes among OECD countries, with rates of maternal distress and complications seven times higher than in the UK. By stepping in with immediate assistance, we help ease these burdens, giving mothers the space to decompress, feel supported, and reconnect with their baby in a positive way.

We operate with the core belief that when we uplift one mother, we strengthen an entire family—and ultimately, the whole community. Our initiatives empower mothers with dignity, respect, and care, ensuring they receive the support they deserve without judgment. Every donation, volunteer effort, and act of generosity contributes to a more connected and compassionate society.

Our impact goes beyond providing material assistance; it fosters hope and resilience. By working together, we create a ripple effect where kindness is paid forward, and families gain the strength to rebuild and thrive. 

Centre Purchaser / Legacy Parter
